Landownership Issues

The Board is trying to obtain clear ownership of Open Space C and Residue C & D on the neighborhood map. Residue C & D and Open Space C are still in question, as well as Dark Star Lane and the Future Right of Way (near the circle). Residue B is now in Chesapeake Village's name. We are still trying to obtain a quick claim deed from Quality Built Homes and Over Water LLC.

Matt Dyer, Esq., is the new attorney on this case. He met with the county and is making progress. He said next order of business is to locate a utility hatch near the traffic circle that would contain important information about the property.

Common Areas

Storm water drainage in Open Space E will need replacing in 50 years. It will be the HOA's responsibility.

The Town Administrator, Holly Wahl, sent an email about creating a place in the neighborhood for children to play. The email was in reaction to residents upset about kids playing wiffle ball on the street on Donerail Court. The Board needs to reply about possibly meeting with her to discuss the situation.

Complaints

There was a complaint about tall grass in a yard on Chesapeake Village Blvd. The homeowner was notified, and the grass was promptly mowed.

There was a complaint about parking on the sidewalk on Cannoncade Court. An email was sent to the homeowner.

There was a complaint about parking in the driveway on Hill Gail Drive in such a manner that it blocks the sidewalk right-of-way. An email was sent to the homeowner.

There was a complaint about the grassy area between Donau and Meridian courts hasn't been mowed. The contractor has been notified.

Committees

Community Improvement Committee: We are still waiting on Part 2 of the drawings from the land space architect (Anik Jhaveri, KOr.10).

Social Committee: The Social Committee chair position remains vacant. The Board would like to fill this position as soon as possible. As a result, we had to cancel the Independence Day parade. We would still like to have a cornhole tournament and a block party.

Welcome Committee: New residents include 3093 Lawrin Court (Shelly), 3688 Middle Ground Court (Jones), 7238 Chesapeake Village Boulevard (Sena).

HOA Covenants Review Committee: If Open Space C becomes Chesapeake Village property, we will need to update the covenants with that information. If that happens, it would be an ideal time to update other parts of the covenants.

Luminaries Committee: The next event is scheduled for December 14, 2024. Amy Everett and Denise Moon are the new coordinators.

Architecture Review Committee

The HOA Board recognizes there should be an Architecture Review Committee consisting of members who are not on the HOA Board. Right now, the HOA Board members are doubling as the Architecture Review Committee. There should be an effort to solicit homeowners to serve as committee members.

Approvals for projects should also include a note that homeowners are responsible for any permits that may need to be obtained from the Town of Chesapeake Beach or Calvert County or the State of Maryland.

Note: The HOA Board will not approve fences, decks, exterior improvements, etc., if the homeowner is "not in good standing," meaning the homeowner has an outstanding inspection violation or has a delinquent account. Also, homeowners will not receive the \$100 annual dues discount if the homeowner is "not in good standing."
